FIVE-DAY TRIP TO FRANCE - February 2020

The French Department is delighted to offer Year 10 and Year 11 pupils studying French the opportunity to take part in a five-day residential trip to France, taking in the sights of the Normandy region and Paris during February 2020. This is the first year we are running this trip and are very excited about the opportunity to take students to these beautiful regions of France.

The trip provides a great opportunity for pupils to develop their language skills acquired in the classroom and to get to know France's history and culture. Students will explore Normandy, where they will visit World War II museums, see the world famous Bayeux Tapestry and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Other highlights of the trip include a visit to Disneyland Paris and a chocolate factory, where students will see the process through to the production of the confectionery, a river cruise along the Seine viewing Paris landmarks from the water.

We will depart on the morning of Monday 3rd February and will travel by coach via the Eurotunnel to Calais, arriving in France at 1pm. We will then spend Monday - Friday enjoying the sights of the regions. We will make the return journey home on Friday, arriving back at LPSB in the evening of Friday 7th February.

The cost of the trip will vary according to the number of students that take part. The price will be between **£464.59** and **£524.96** depending on the number of students taking part. The price includes return coach and tunnel travel, half-board accommodation (breakfast and evening meal), lunch and all activities.

If you would like your son to take part, please sign and return the slip to your son's French teacher or to me, Miss Alhinai, in room 458 and pay the **£100** deposit by **Friday 20th September**. Three subsequent payments according to student participation will be due on sQuid by **Friday 25th October**, **Friday 29th November** and the final instalment due by **Friday 20th December**.

Payment should be made online by sQuid (www.squidcard.com) using the same log-in for when topping up lunch cards. If the username/password has been forgotten this can be obtained by logging into sQuid and into the section entitled 'sign in to my account'. Once you are logged on, you will then be given the option to top up the lunch card or to pay for trips. There are four instalments on squid for this trip, 'KS4 Normandy Trip' and you can pay for them individually or altogether. If you have never registered on sQuid, please contact finance@lpsb.org.uk for details.

We anticipate that this trip will be very popular trip and over-subscribed; in the event that we receive, more replies than there are places available, names will be drawn randomly from a hat at 1pm on Monday 30th September and any deposits will be refunded.

Due to the current situation with Brexit, your son must have his own passport with **at least 6 months validity** and EHIC (European Health Insurance Card) in order to participate in this trip. EHICs can be applied for online (www.ehic.org.uk) or by post, with application forms available at any main Post Office.
