Year 13 Pre-Public Examinations (PPEs)

I am writing to inform you that all Year 13 students will be sitting their pre-public examinations (PPEs) in all of their subjects during the week beginning **Monday 25th February**. During this time students will be required to attend normal lessons and class teachers will inform students the date of their examinations. Students will not be given “study leave” to help them prepare for the assessments.

These PPEs will provide excellent preparation for the external examinations which will take place in little over three months. They will also give students and their teachers valuable information about their current levels of performance, students’ strengths and those areas that they need to develop further. All students should be clear on which topics to prepare for and should see the importance of these examinations. Following the PPE week class teachers will mark the assessments and the results for all of the examinations will be revealed in the “PPE Results Afternoon” which will take place on **Wednesday 13th March**. Form tutors and the sixth form management team will be available during this time to offer support and guidance.

These Pre-Public Examinations are an important “staging-post” in students’ preparation for their exams in the summer. Please encourage your son or daughter to take these exams seriously and to undertake adequate revision. Students should consult their classroom teachers for support on topics to revise. I would also like to take this opportunity to remind you of the Year 13 parents’ evening which will take place on Thursday 14th March. This will be a particularly important parents’ evening as it will be an opportunity to review the PPE results but also to outline what needs to be done to prepare for the final exams in May and June.

I wish your son or daughter every success with their PPEs and we are grateful for your continuing support to help them achieve their potential.
