Dear Families,

French Reading and Listening workbook purchase offer to all pupils of GCSE French (£2.70)

In order to best support your son for the Reading and Listening GCSE exams in May 2020, I would like to use the workbook "**REVISE AQA GCSE French revision (9-1) French Workbook**" as a basis for homework and revision over the next 12 weeks leading up to the exam.

This workbook accompanies the Studio course, which we have been using in class in the past two years. It contains dozens of Vocabulary, Reading and Listening activities on each of the themes and topics we have been teaching during the GCSE course. All of these activities aim to cement your son's French reading and listening skills at grades 4 to 9. All listening recordings are available for independent study via the Pearson website. We will be setting weekly homework from this workbook and it would be in your son's best interest to purchase a copy.

Could I therefore please ask for your contribution in the purchase of your son's workbook **at the reduced price of £2.70 (instead of £5.99)**? Payment should only be made online by sQuid (www.squidcard.com) using the same login as when topping up lunch cards **by the 29th February 2020**. If the username/password has been forgotten this can be obtained by logging into sQuid and into the section entitled 'sign in to my account'. Once you are logged on, you will then be given the option to top up the lunch card or to pay for trips. There is one payment on squid for this trip, '**RAG French GCSE Workbook**'. If you have never registered on sQuid then please contact finance@lpsb.org.uk for details.

In order for your son to have the best chance of success next summer, ideally, I am asking for your support to help him work through this workbook between now and May, so that he is fully prepared for the start of exam season. I would like him to complete the weekly homework as required, and his French teacher will ask to see his workbook every week to ensure he is up to date, and to give him an opportunity to ask any questions that may have arisen during his independent study.

Please could you help by ensuring that your son is working through his workbook?
