They must also know exercises to develop these skills.</p> <p>Section B: Students must reflect on their practical work and are asked to explain how their use of physical/expressive/ technical or mental skills have contributed to the effectiveness of their performance.</p> <p>Section C: students are asked longer answer questions where they will describe features of the set works and analyse how they communicate the choreographic intention of the piece.
