Minutes per week

- Five 60 min lessons per day
- Students in sets 1 and 2 for MFL directed towards Ebacc. All students welcome to study Ebacc if they want to.
- Langley Bacc heavily promoted (Ebacc plus at least one creative/sporting subject)
- Where triple science is studied, it takes up one option block (7 hours of science in total)
- 60 mins of PSHCE each fortnight. PSHCE moves across the timetable for the whole school. M1, M2, M3, M4, T1, etc.
- Diversity Day for all. RSE day for Year 11
- Compulsory RS covered in PSHCE for those not studying GCSE RS
- Food Tech vocational course (non-GCSE) now available for students, alongside Langley Diploma (ASDAN provision) and new Sport BTEC this year
- ICT covered across the curriculum for those not studying GCSE Computer Science or BTEC ICT
- AM registration lasts 25 mins – Year 10 - Class readers 3 times per week, careers talks are part of the programme, Themed assembly once per week, year group assembly (optional) once a week.
- Year 11 – Period 0 - 25 mins of English/Maths/Science three times per week, on rotation. All students do all three across the year. Themed assembly once per week, year group assembly (optional) once a week.
- PM registration lasts 15 mins (Year 10 and Year 11) – admin or online assembly once per week, optional online assemblies for year groups throughout the week. Students same with the same tutor AM and PM on a 3-part carousel

- 60 mins of PSHCE each fortnight. PSHCE moves across the timetable for the whole school. M1, M2, M3, M4, T1, etc.
- Diversity Day for all. RSE day for Year 12
- AM registration lasts 25 mins – Private reading, private study, careers once per fortnight (12), UCAS preparation (13), Themed assembly once per week, year group assembly (optional) once a week.
- PM registration lasts 15 mins (Year 10 and Year 11) – admin or online assembly once per week, optional online assemblies for year groups throughout the week.
