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LPSB Pupil Premium Support Programme 2023-24

Dear Families,

I am writing to you as, according to our records, your son is eligible for Pupil Premium. This means that he is entitled to additional academic, pastoral and financial support at school.

At Langley Park School for Boys we have a clear programme of support for students eligible for Pupil Premium.

1. Pupil Premium Annual Review

We will hold an Annual Review each academic year with your son to discuss his progress, strengths and any barriers to his learning. We will also discuss any support which may be beneficial to him.

2. Pupil Premium Passport

We will put together a passport containing key information about your son's interests, strengths and needs, which all teachers will use to ensure that he receives personalised support in the classroom.

3. Literacy and Numeracy Support

We will offer Breakfast Booster sessions for selected students in Years 7 to 10 who have been identified as requiring additional support in English or Maths. These will be small group sessions in which targeted students will be supported to work on aspects of the English or Maths curriculum which they have found challenging. The aim is to build confidence and accelerate progress. Please contact me directly if you would like your son to be involved in these sessions.

5. Regular Progress Review Meetings

All Pupil Premium students will have regular Progress Review Meetings with their Tutor, Head of Year or Assistant Head of Year. This will be an opportunity to discuss their strengths and areas for development and will take place at least once per term, usually following a Report Week.

6. Priority Guidance at Key Transition Points

We will offer all Pupil Premium students priority guidance at key transition points to enable them to make informed decisions about their next steps. This includes support with the Year 9 options process, post-16 routes and Sixth Form or college applications. Careers interviews are available for all PP students who would like additional guidance.

7. Additional Academic Support

Where a Pupil Premium student is under-performing in a particular academic subject, we will work with the Head of Department and Subject Teacher to ensure that additional support is put in place. Where interventions are run, under-performing Pupil Premium students will have priority of attendance.

8. Financial Support for Academic Resources



Financial support is available for students who are eligible for Pupil Premium to assist them with their learning and ensure that they can access the curriculum. This can be used to support students with the purchase of textbooks, stationery or specialist equipment which may be required for a particular academic subject. If you would like to request financial support for any of the above, please speak to your son's tutor or contact me directly.

9. Financial Support for School Uniform or Kit

Financial support is also available to support families with the purchase of school uniform or specialist kit, such as for sport or dance. These costs will go through the school's hardship fund with families required to submit requests on a financial assistance form which can be requested from your son's tutor or from me directly. It will be looked at by the pupil premium and finance team and the school will shortly afterwards be in contact with you, in order that you can complete your purchase. Please do not purchase items without prior approval as there is a limited pot of money available and items will not necessarily automatically be refunded.

10. Financial Support for Curricular Trips and Visits

There is also limited financial support available to enable Pupil Premium students to take part in trips and visits which are directly related to the curriculum, such as field trips, or which are an integral part of the culture of the school, such as Dover Camp, Borrowdale and Youghreave. If you would like to request financial support for any of the above, please speak to your son's tutor or contact me directly.

If your son requires any other academic, pastoral or financial support, or if you have any concerns about his progress, please do not hesitate to contact his Head of Year, Tutor or me directly to discuss.
