LPSB Pupil Premium Support Programme

At Langley Park School for Boys, we are committed to supporting your young person in achieving their full academic potential. Our Pupil Premium programme provides targeted interventions and guidance to help all eligible students succeed.

Our approach focuses on the Three Ts: Targeted, Timely, and Tailored support, ensuring that every student receives the help they need to thrive academically and socially, while raising both attainment and aspiration.

Targeted: We monitor each student's progress closely, offering support based on their individual needs. This includes academic guidance and extra-curricular opportunities, as well as priority support at key transition points to ensure informed decisions about their future. These key transition points include:

- **Key Stage 2 to 3**: Helping students settle into secondary school.
- **Key Stage 3 to 4**: Guidance through the GCSE options process.
- Key Stage 4 to 5: Support in post-16 pathways, including A-Level and other academic routes at LPSB, as well as support to explore other institutions such as sixth forms, colleges, or apprenticeships.
- Beyond Key Stage 5: Comprehensive support as students transition into higher education, apprenticeships, or employment, ensuring they leave school confident, well-prepared, and equipped for the next stage of their journey.

Timely: When challenges arise, we act quickly to ensure students receive the right support. Early intervention helps them develop strategies to overcome obstacles and make steady progress.

Tailored: We aim to help students build resilience and navigate challenges effectively by providing support suited to their strengths and areas for improvement.

We also offer various resources and opportunities to support learning. Some of these include:

- Homework Club: Available daily from 1.15pm to 1.45pm in a computer room. This is an opportunity for students to complete work in a focused environment. All Pupil Premium students have the right to attend.
- Literacy and Numeracy Booster Sessions: Priority attendance for Pupil Premium students at morning booster sessions. These are designed to improve essential skills and help students stay on track.
- Growth and Guidance Meetings: We will soon invite you to a meeting with your young person and their Head or Assistant Head of Year. This meeting will focus on strategies to support their learning, identify barriers, and set clear, actionable targets that can be monitored by their form tutor. Your involvement in this process is crucial, as your support at home will help them stay on track and achieve their full potential.
