Frequently Asked Questions

What is the 100 Club Library Fund?

The 100 Club Library Fund is a lottery run in support of the school library. Draws are made at the end of each month starting at the end of September and running until August.

How does it work?

Each member pays £12 per year per share, which puts them in to a monthly draw, with the chance of winning £50 per draw. The prize money is dependent on there being 100 members. If there are more than 100 members then the prize money will increase. In 2024-2025 we sold enough shares that the monthly pay out was £135!

50% of all income will be allocated as prize money. Each member is allocated an individual number per share.

Who can join?

Parents, pupils, family members and friends. Under 16's are **NOT** allowed to take part as per the Gambling Act 2005. Applicants aren't limited to one share.

How does it help the library?

50% of all money taken in membership goes to the school library. So far the library has benefited by receiving just under £20,500 since the start of the 100 club in 2005.

How can I join?

By submitting a membership form and remittance and sending it in to the school office, either through email, post or by hand.
