Langley Park School for Boys Celebrates Outstanding A-Level and BTEC Results

Langley Park School for Boys is proud to celebrate another year of excellent achievement, as our Year 13 students receive their A-Level and BTEC results. These outcomes reflect the hard work, determination, and ambition of our students, supported by a committed teaching staff and a strong learning community.

With over 300 students receiving their A-Level results, we are pleased to report that nearly 900 individual qualifications have been awarded. 56% of A-Level grades were A*-B, with 24% at A*-A, and an impressive 79% at A*-C. The overall pass rate stands at 99.1%, highlighting the consistent effort and high standards demonstrated by students and staff alike.

Our BTEC students have also excelled, with 54% achieving Distinction grades, 88% attaining Merit or above, and a 98% overall pass rate. These achievements reflect the broad range of talents across our student body and the diverse academic pathways we offer.

Many of our students are now moving on to prestigious universities, including the Russell Group, while others are taking up competitive apprenticeships or entering directly into employment. These outcomes show how well-prepared our students are for the next stage of their journeys.

We are particularly proud to recognise two of our highest achievers this year:

- Meghan Bannister (A*AA), who met her offer to study Biochemistry at the University of Oxford, and
- Carla Forsyth (A*A*A*), who will be studying Medicine at the University of Oxford.

Their accomplishments are exceptional and a testament to their talent and dedication.

Our diverse and ambitious Sixth Form curriculum continues to enable students to thrive. We are proud to offer a supportive, high-achieving environment where every student is encouraged to fulfil their potential.

Students at Langley Park School for Boys continue to thrive with a broad and diverse Sixth Form curriculum. In 2025, we celebrate the outstanding achievements of our A Level students in Maths and the Sciences: **Maths** (36% A+, 64% A+B), **Further Maths** (67% A+, 83% A+B), and **Chemistry** (45% A+, 68% A+B). Exceptional performances were also seen in **Religious Studies** (50% A+, 100% A+B), **Photography** (38% A+, 85% A+B), and **Physical Education** (25% A+, 81% A+B). We are proud of our Languages department, with **German** securing 100% A+B. Other notable successes include **Music Technology** (46% A+, 62% A+B) and **History** (20% A+, 61% A+B), reflecting the dedication and talent of both students and staff across our Sixth Form.

At Langley Park School for Boys, we believe in educating the whole child and being ambitious for every child. We aim to nurture individual potential and prepare our students for a future full of opportunity. These results are a testament to what can be achieved through determination, support, and a strong sense of purpose.
