Outstanding GCSE Results at Langley Park School for Boys

Langley Park School for Boys is once again celebrating the exceptional achievements of its Year 11 students, as the Class of 2025 receives a superb set of GCSE results.

Despite the many challenges faced by this cohort—including disrupted learning during the pandemic and the absence of KS2 SATs—our students have demonstrated resilience, determination, and dedication throughout their GCSE courses. Their hard work has paid off, and we are incredibly proud of everything they have accomplished.

With over 200 students receiving their results this summer, the cohort achieved close to 2,000 qualifications in total. Impressively, 31% of all grades awarded were 9–7, significantly outperforming the national average for boys at 19%. The overall pass rate (grades 9–4) reached 83%, which is a remarkable 19% above the national average for boys.

Headteacher Suzanne Munday said:

"I am very proud of everything our students have achieved this year. They have worked extremely hard to achieve these results with the help of our fantastic team of teachers and support staff here at LPSB. I wish our year 11s all the best for their next steps whether they are staying here for sixth form or going to another school, college or education provider. Thank you also to all our families and the wider LPSB community for supporting our year 11s through their GCSEs."

The school's commitment to a broad and ambitious curriculum continues to yield excellent outcomes. Particular highlights this year include:

The core subjects of English and Mathematics continue to perform strongly, with 83% of students achieving a pass in both subjects, and 60% securing strong passes (grades 5 and above). Additionally, 49% of the cohort achieved the **EBacc qualification**, highlighting the school's continued focus on academic breadth and rigour.

We extend our heartfelt thanks to our families, who have supported their children and the school throughout this journey, and to our staff, whose tireless work and high expectations have played a vital role in this success.

Congratulations to the Class of 2025 on a truly outstanding set of results. We look forward to seeing many of them continue their journey with us in the Sixth Form and beyond.






